7. CCoA Sponsored Bills and Legislative Update - Discussion

A. Sponsored Bills

- a. AB 1993 (Kalra) Residential Care Facilities for the Elderly. Both the Department of Social Services and Department of Justice indicated a significant cost for the bill. Staff expect the bill to stall in appropriations.
- b. AB 2207 (Reyes) State Boards and Commissions: Seniors. Karol and former Commissioner Rita Saenz testified at the Assembly Aging and Long-Term Care Committee on April 16, 2024. Passed Appropriations on consent. If the Department of Health Care Access and Information indicates once again there would be a cost to add members to the California Health Workforce Education and Training Council, the bill will be amended to remove the Council to ensure the bill moves forward.
- c. AB 2620 (Bains) Modernizing CCoA Statute in the Older Californians Act. Karol testified at the Assembly Aging and Long-Term Care Committee on April 16, 2024. The bill moved to Appropriations.
- d. SB 1249 (Roth) Older Californians Act: Area Agencies on Aging. Scheduled for a hearing in the Senate Appropriations Committee on April 29, 2024.
